QS/1®'s Home Medical Equipment Point-of-Sale (HME POS) provides an innovative way for HME businesses to manage cash sales and the collection of co-payments at the time of delivery. HME POS makes it easier to manage HME inventory with greater profitability, and HME POS integrates with your existing SystemOne for HME software so there is no need to re-enter data into the POS system.

Enhance Retail Profitability

Manage front-end cash sales like you manage insurance and billing with SystemOne. HME POS handles cash sales, assists in collecting co-payments, non-assigned and not covered patient amounts at the time of delivery. The system will help you identify and track trends, fast and slow-moving items and seasonal sales to maximize profitability.

Return on Investment

With its careful attention to profitability and loss management, HME POS pays for itself by reducing losses due to cashier errors and unauthorized discounts. Prices will be updated from your SystemOne item file to reduce possible pricing errors.

Speedy Checkout

HME POS will make customer checkout fast, easy and flexible for staff and customers and will validate and process a variety of payment methods for greater convenience. GTIN (formerly UPC) bar codes will allow for more accurate inventory management and faster checkout.

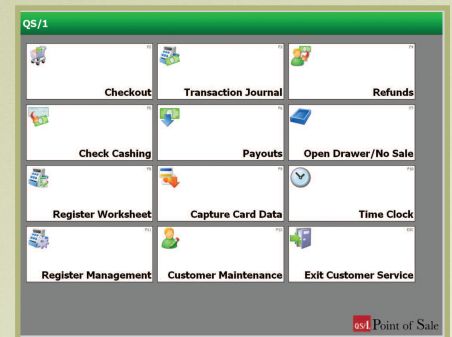
System Integration

HME POS integrates with SystemOne in three ways:

- Patient portions from SystemOne delivery tickets can be easily transferred to HME POS for payment. SystemOne delivery tickets have a bar code that when scanned at the HME POS register automatically transfers any patient portions (co-pay, non-assigned and/or not covered amounts) to HME POS module for payment. Adjustments are automatically entered into SystemOne, noting that the patient portion was transferred to HME POS.
- HME POS also integrates seamlessly with SystemOne's Inventory module. All pricing is stored in SystemOne and is used by the HME POS module when items are sold. Quantities sold through HME POS are automatically deducted from SystemOne's Inventory quantity on hand, which provides integrated purchasing for both SystemOne and HME POS.
- With SystemOne's optional Accounts Receivables module, customers can charge their cash purchases and receive a statement at the end of the month.

QS/1 can schedule training on your HME POS module to meet your needs. Once you go live, SystemOne software support specialists are only a toll-free call away.

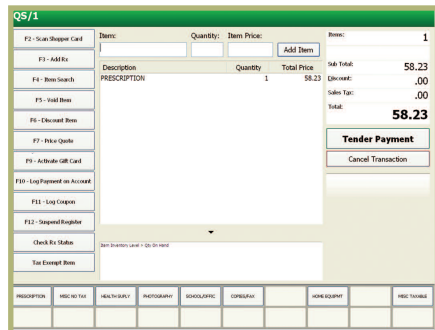

Enhance Customer Checkout

Optional HME & RX POS Interface

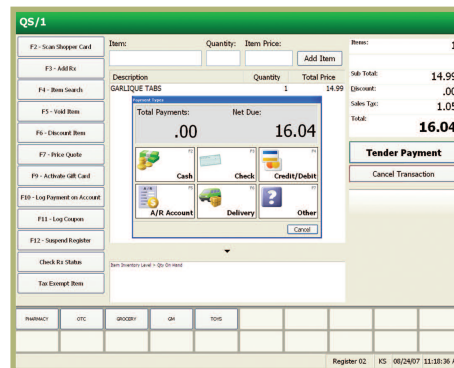
Completely integrate your sales and accounts receivable process with the HME & RX POS Interface. For businesses already using QS/1's SystemOne, NRx® or RxCare Plus® or and pharmacy POS, the HME & RX POS Interface allows you to completely integrate the sales process for prescriptions, OTC items and now HME items.

■ Sales Integration

When an item is scanned at the register, the POS program always looks to see if the item exists in the SystemOne item file. If the item is found in SystemOne, then pricing is pulled from SystemOne to ensure Medicare compliance. In addition, the quantity sold is deducted from SystemOne's inventory, maintaining an accurate inventory count.

■ Payments and Accounts Receivable Integration

As with regular HME POS, patient portions from SystemOne delivery tickets can be easily transferred to HME & RX POS for payment. Patient portions may be paid using cash, check or credit/debit card or you can charge the remaining balance to your pharmacy POS. This, combined with transferring patient balances from SystemOne's Accounts Receivable allows you to generate a single patient statement for all patient sales - prescriptions, OTC items and HME items.
